Reporting Mistreatment or Non-Compliance

Concerns Regarding the care or Treatment of animals used in research or teaching activities at North Carolina Research Campus (NCRC) should be immediately reported to NCRC IACUC Compliance Hotline or to the Attending Veterinarian.

The IACUC Office is responsible for ensuring that all animal used in research and teaching are treated in accordance with the Federal Animal Welfare Act, the PHS "Policy on Humane Care and Use of Animal", the NIH Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animal and all other applicable government regulations and institutional policies.

If you suspect any deficiencies in animal care or treatment or have any questions or concerns about the specific use of animals at or in association with research conducted at the NCRC, you are encouraged to contact:
